Check-in at Hartnett Arena at 10:30 a.m. or immediately following your last final

After check in, you will board buses to go to Camp Thurman in Arlington. Last bus departs at 11:20 !!!!

Buses will return to Nolan Catholic at 4 p.m. **ALL STUDENTS MUST RIDE BUSES TO AND FROM PICNIC.**

Upon arrival at Camp Thurman, you will receive a colored wrist band either red or blue. Try to board the bus with your 'group of friends' because those who arrive in the first few buses will receive one color and the last few buses will receive the other.

You can hang out with everyone in both groups at any time, however, you can do the activities with your color group.

The main reason for this is three of the activities require a harness and it is too time consuming to take these on and off.

If no one is waiting in line, any color band may use an activity, however, those with the correct color band will get priority and go to the front of the line during their time period.
