

## **LONG TERM PROJECTS**

Many NCHS students continually do ministry with the same agency with loyalty and faithfulness. This is to be commended and is truly at the heart of the purpose of the Christian Ministry Program. In order to more easily facilitate the documentation of hours for these long term projects, a student may submit a project proposal to the Director of Christian Ministry, outlining the scope and sequence of their plan with the agency. After a face to face meeting with the Director about the project, if approved, the student then proceeds with their ministry. At the conclusion of the project, the student then submits both documentation of the work completed as well as a reflection paper on what was done and how it helped others. Projects are NOT bound by the six week deadline. Projects may span two or more months, and all hours are then turned in at the end of the project along with the reflection paper. However, students who opt out of the reflection paper in the end will then have all their hours subject to the six week rule and will risk losing some of them. Students who opt to document a long term project will receive an additional 5 Christian Ministry hours over and above those documented by the agency. These hours are in compensation for the time involved with the proposal, interview, and reflection paper that must be done.
